ORDER

1. **Brief facts** of the case are that the has filed a Complaint case before the Commission registered on 06/06/2019 being aggrieved that despite furnishing the correct house number and other details as per the directions given by the First Appellate Authority (FAA) in the order dated 27/02/2019, the PIO has not furnish the information as sought in the RTI application dated 30/11/2018. The information pertained to a property having PT Sheet No.114 in Chalta No.26, Road No.05, lake view colony, Miramar, Goa and the Complainant is *inter alia* seeking the name of the present owner and whether the CCP has issued any trade license for starting a commercial or Play School activity in the said property.
2. **HEARING:** During hearing is represented by Adv. Sahil Sardesai whose Vakalatnama is on record. The Respondent PIO is represented by Shri. Sunil Das, LDC with the Public Authority, who undertakes to file letter of authority. The FAA is absent.

3. **SUBMISSIONS**: Advocate S. Sardesai submits that the PIO has not furnished the information even after providing him with details of the house No, photograph of the house, card Number and other such details as per the order of the First Appellate Authority (FAA) dated 27/02/2019
4. The representative for the PIO, Shri. Sunil Das submits that the said information was kept ready and furnishes a copy of the detail of information along with enclosures which is taken on record. One copy is served on the other side.
5. The Advocate S. Sardesai after receiving the information and perusing the same expresses satisfaction and states that the Commission may proceed to disposed of the matter.
6. **FINDINGS**: The Commission finds that two pages of House Assessment Tax form alongwith copies of Assessment report under Section 3 of the Goa Daman & Diu, Municipal Act, 1968 have been furnished to the satisfaction of the .
7. **DECISION**: As the desired information has been furnished. Nothing further survives in the Complaint case which accordingly stands disposed.

All proceedings in Complaint case stands closed. Pronounced before the parties who are present at the conclusion of the hearing. Notify the parties concerned. Authenticated copies of the order be given free of cost.
