- 1. Aggrieved by non receipt of information and non hearing of first appeal, appellant under Section 19 (3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act') filed second appeal against Respondent No. 1, Public Information Officer (PIO) and Respondent No. 2, First Appellate Authority (FAA), which came before the Commission on 23/06/2021.
- 2. It is the contention of the appellant that, vide application dated 24/03/2021 he had sought certain information. Upon not receiving any reply from PIO he filed appeal before the FAA, which was not heard by the authority within the mandatory period. Hence, he approached the Commission by way of second appeal.
- 3. Notice was issued, pursuant to which appellant and PIO appeared in person, whereas, FAA was represented by his authorised representative. PIO filed reply dated 08/09/2021, 05/01/2022 and compliance report on 29/08/2022.
- 4. It is seen that Shri. Vyankatesh Sawant, PIO, Technical Section collected the appeal memo, however, the subject matter was

pertaining to the Accounts Taxation section, hence Shri. Sawant handed over the matter to Smt. Smita Fal Desai, Acting PIO, Accounts Taxation Officer. Later, Smt. Smita Fal Desai handed over the matter to Smt. Seema Velip, upon her posting as Accounts Taxation Officer. PIO Smt. Seema Velip furnished part information and upon her transfer, delivered the matter to the new PIO, Shri. Abhay Rane.

- 5. During the hearing on 08/09/2022, Shri. Abhay Rane, PIO, Accounts Taxation Section stated that, he has furnished the remaining information to the appellant and has filed compliance report alongwith acknowledgment from the appellant. Later, on 28/09/2022 appellant appeared before the Commission and stated that he has received the information and he is satisfied with the same.
- 6. In the background of the facts mentioned above, the Commission finds that, the information has been furnished and the appellant has acknowledged the receipt of the same. Hence, the prayer for information becomes infructuous and nothing more remains to be decided in the present matter.
- 7. Thus, the present appeal is disposed accordingly and the proceeding stands closed.
