# <u>ORDER</u>

- 1. The second appeal filed by the appellant under Section 19 (3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act') against Respondent No. 1, Public Information Officer (PIO) and Respondent No. 2, First Appellate Authority (FAA), came before the Commission on 22/08/2022.
- 2. Notice was issued to both the sides and the matter was taken up for hearing. Appellant and PIO appeared in person on 03/10/2022 wherein, PIO undertook to furnish the information to the appellant and apologized for the delay. During the hearing on 31/10/2022 appellant stated that he has received the information from the appellant, hence he does not wish to proceed in the matter, and that he requests the Commission to dispose the present appeal.
- 3. The Commission finds that the information sought by the appellant has been furnished by the PIO during the proceeding of the instant

matter and appellant and PIO has requested for disposal of the appeal. Since the information has been received by the appellant, prayer for information becomes infructuous and no more intervention of the Commission is required in the matter.

4. Thus, the present appeal is disposed accordingly and the proceeding stands closed.
