ORDER

- 1. The second appeal filed by the appellant under Section 19 (3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act'), against Respondent No. 1, First Appellate Authority (FAA), and Respondent No. 2, Public Information Officer (PIO), came before the Commission on 19/05/2023.
- 2. The brief facts of this case, as contended by the appellant are that, the appellant had sought certain information from the PIO. Being aggrieved by the action of the PIO and the FAA, he preferred second appeal before the Commission.
- 3. Notice was issued to the parties, pursuant to which appellant appeared in person, filed submission dated 19/07/2023 and rejoinder dated 27/09/2023. Shri. Akshay G. Potekar, PIO appeared in person and filed reply dated 28/06/2023, rejoinder dated 07/09/2023 and on 27/09/2023 filed affidavit in rejoinder. Smt. Aqualina Furtado, Senior

Stenographer appeared on behalf of the FAA under authority letter and filed submission dated 19/07/2023.

- 4. Upon perusal of the records of the matter it is seen that, the PIO had responded to the application within the stipulated period and later during the current appeal proceeding furnished the information as available and the same has been received by the appellant. The PIO had never refused the request for information and was always willing to co-operate with the appellant and the authorities.
- 5. With the above observations the Commission notes that, the information as available has been furnished to the appellant and there is no need for any further intervention of this authority in the present matter.
- 6. Hence, the instant appeal is disposed accordingly and the proceeding stands closed.
