- 1. Being aggrieved by non furnishing of the information in spite of the direction by the First Appellate Authority (FAA), appellant under Section 19 (3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 filed second appeal against Respondent Public Information Officer (PIO), which came before the Commission on 17/01/2023.
- 2. During the hearing on 15/03/2023, Advocate Narayan R. Pai appered on behalf of the PIO, filed wakalatnama and undertook to furnish complete information to the appellant before next date of hearing. Accordingly, next hearing was fixed on 03/04/2023 for compliance.
- 3. Advocate Narayan R. Pai appeared on behalf of the PIO on 03/04/2023 and stated that as undertaken complete information has been furnished to the appellant. Appellant, who was present in person acknowledged receipt of the information and requested the Commission to allow him to withdraw the present appeal.
- 4. Upon perusal the Commission finds that, the information sought by the appellant vide application dated 17/10/2022 has been furnished, though after delay, for which PIO has apologised. Similarly, appellant after receiving the information has sought permission of the authority to withdraw the appeal. Hence, the Commission concludes that as

the information has been furnished to the satisfaction of the appellant, no more intervention of the Commission is required in the present matter.

5. Thus, the present appeal is disposed as withdrawn and proceeding stands closed.
