FACTS IN BRIEF

- Dr. Kalpana Kamat filed an RTI application dated 31/07/2023 to the PIO, Directorate of Land Records, Panaji-Goa seeking 8 points information pertaining to land details of 45 Chalta numbers in Bhute Bhat, Bellabat and Baina in Vasco Village after inspection of files.
- 2. Since some of the information sought by the Appellant pertains to the office of the Inspector of Survey and Land Records, City Survey, Vasco-da-Gama, Goa, a copy of RTI application was transferred to that office by the PIO, Directorate of Settlement of Land Records, Panaji-Goa.
- 3. PIO, Inspector of Survey & Land Records, Vasco vide letter dated 15/11/2023 informed the PIO, Directorate of Settlement of Land Records, that with respect to Point No. 4 of the RTI application, the

- information is not readily available in the office and it will take time to create / search the information. As regards to Point No. 7 & 8, the information is not maintained by the office.
- 4. Appellant then filed first appeal to the First Appellate Authority (Superintendent of Survey & Land Records, Margao) stating that till date no response received from the PIO, Office of the Inspector of Survey & Land Records, Vasco. FAA vide order dated 12/03/2024 directed the PIO to furnish the copies of the documents sought by the Appellant available in the records of the Office of the Inspector of Survey & Land Records, Vasco within 10 days.
- 5. Aggrieved by incorrect and incomplete information received from the PIO on 05/04/2024 and no order of FAA received till date (31/05/2024), Appellant preferred second appeal dated 31/05/2024 before the Commission.
- 6. Pursuant to the second appeal dated 31/05/2024, parties were notified and the matter was taken up for hearing before the State Chief Information Commissioner on 31/01/2025.
- 7. Respondent PIO submitted that he had furnished information available in his office to the Appellant and the FAA had issued formal order dated 05/03/2024 in the first appeal and a copy of the same handed over to the Appellant while proceeding were on in the second appeal today i.e. 31/01/2025.
- 8. During the hearing today i.e. 31/01/2025 before the State Chief Information Commissioner, it has come to know that this particular Appeal No. 123/2024/SCIC is part of Appellant's original RTI application dated 31/07/2023 and the Appellant has already filed another appeal in this regards before the Commission bearing Appeal No. 410/2023/SIC which is under hearing before State Information Commissioner. First hearing in this appeal was held before the State Information Commissioner on 10/01/2025.

- 9. Since the same matter is going on before the State Information Commissioner in Appeal No. 410/2023/SIC, there is no merit in taking up the same matter in a different appeal (Appeal No. 123/2024/SCIC). Hence, the Appeal No. 123/2024/SCIC is disposed today i.e. 31/01/2025 as no further proceeding warranted in it.
