1. The Appellant, Anjali Patil, has preferred the present appeal praying that information requested by the Appellant be furnished to her fully and correctly without reserving any information to save any person/persons; for an undertaking from the Public Information officer, that he will act on irregularities.

2. The brief facts leading to the present appeal are as under:-

That the Appellant, vide her application dated 12/04/2010, sought certain information under Right to Information Act 2005('RTI'Act for short) from the Public Information Officer ('PIO') Deputy Director of Panchayat, Panaji. That the application was complete in all respects and submitted in person. That no reply was received and hence the Appellant visited the office of Respondent No. 2 where it was informed that his application was transferred to Respondent No. 1 under 6(3)(ii) of Right to Information Act. That the said transfer was not intimated to the Appellant. Since information was not furnished the Appellant preferred the First Appeal. That the appeal was allowed directing Respondent No. 1 to furnish the information. Being aggrieved by non-furnishing of the information the appellant has preferred the present appeal.

3. In pursuance of the notice the Respondent No. 1 appeared. He did not file any reply as such, however, he advanced arguments.
4. Heard Shri Anil Patil, Representative of Appellant as well as Respondent No.1.
5. During the course of arguments Shri Anil Patil the representative of the Appellant submitted that the appellant has received the information fully. According to him Appellant is fully satisfied with the information and that the Appellant has no grievance of any sort against the Respondents and that the Appellant does not wish to proceed further.
6. Since information is furnished no further intervention of this Commission is required. The appeal is liable to be disposed. Hence I pass the following order:-

ORDER

No further intervention of this Commission is required as information is fully furnished. The appeal is disposed off.

The appeal is accordingly disposed off.
