## JUDGMENT (17.01.2011)

- 1. The Appellant, Shri Albert I. P. Rodrigues, has filed the present Appeal praying that Public Information Officer be directed to provide the information to send copies of agreements, documents, etc; that penalty be imposed on Public Information Officer and to reprimand first Appellate Authority.
- 2. It is the case of the appellant that vide application dated 11.03.2010 he sought certain information under Right to Information Act, 2005 ('R.T.I. Act' for short) from the Public Information Officer/('P.I.O.')/Respondent No.
- 1. That P.I.O. did not send the same as instructed. Being not satisfied the Appellant preferred Appeal. Being aggrieved the Appellant preferred this Appeal.

3. It is the case of the Respondent No. 1 that vide letter dated

08.04.2010 has informed the Appellant that information is ready and to

collect the same. That the party has not collected the same which has been

kept ready in the office. According to the Respondent No. 1 Appeal is bad

and liable to be dismissed.

4. I have carefully gone through the records of the case. However, I

need not refer to all these aspects as an application has been filed by

Advocate for Appellant alongwith vakalatnama and Power of Attorney,

praying to allow the Appellant to withdraw the Appeal. It is seen that the

Appellant has received the information.

5. In any case since information is received no intervention of this

Commission is required. Request of the Appellant is to be granted and the

Appellant be allowed to withdraw the Appeal. Hence, I pass the following

Order:

<u>ORDER</u>

No intervention of this Commission is required. The Appeal is

disposed off as withdrawn.

Appeal is accordingly disposed off.
