O R D E R (19.08.2011)

- 1. By Order dated 12.05.2010 the Complainant was given an opportunity to prove that information furnished is incorrect, incomplete, misleading, etc. Accordingly, enquiry was posted on 28.05.2010. On 28.05.2010 the Complainant filed application. On 22.07.2010 the Advocate for Opponent submitted that no affidavit was filed and Complainant agreed to file affidavit on the next date. However, from 13.08.2010 the Complainant remained absent. The matter was posted on 09.09.2010 on which date the Complainant remained absent. Notice was issued to the Complainant to remain present on 05.05.2010 but he remained From 05.05.2010 till date various opportunities were given to the absent. Complainant to remain present. However, he did not remain present. It appears that Complainant is not interested in proceeding with the matter.
- 2. On 07.02.2011 arguments were heard. Adv. Shri J. Ramaiyya submitted that Complainant did not file the affidavit and this itself shows that he has received the documents. He next submitted that whatever information they had, they have furnished. He further submitted that under RTI available information

is to be furnished. Thereafter, the matter was posted for Order. Again, notice was issued to the Complainant to remain present but he did not remain present. Matter was posted on 25.02.2011, 22.03.2011, 19.04.2011, 27.05.2011 and 14.06.2011. However, the Complainant did not remain present. It appears that Complainant is not interested in proceeding with the matter. Hence, I pass the following Order:-

ORDER

Inquiry proceedings are dropped.

The inquiry is accordingly disposed off.
