J U D G M E N T
(29/03/2012)

1. The Appellant, Smt. Effina A. Fernandes, has filed the present appeal praying that the directions to provide the information with compensation as deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the cause matter.

2. The brief facts leading to the present appeal are as under:-

That the appellant vide application dated 29/10/2010 sought certain information under the Right to Information Act, 2005 ('R.T.I. Act' for short) from the Public Information Officer(P.I.O.)/respondent. That the respondent failed to furnish the information within the specified period. Being aggrieved the appellant preferred the appeal before First Appellate Authority. That the FAA directed the respondent to furnish the information within 7 days from the date of the order dated 2/2/2011. Since the respondent failed to furnish the information the appellant preferred the present appeal.

3. In pursuance of the notice issued the respondent appeared. Subsequently his advocate R.N. Jurali also appeared. The respondent did not file any reply as such. However, he submitted that information is furnished.

4. Matter was posted on 29/3/2012 on which date appellant filed an application to dispose and close the appeal as P.I.O. has furnished the complete information.

5. Since information is furnished and since appellant has no grievance of any sort, no intervention of this Commission is required. Hence I pass the following order.

ORDER

No intervention of this Commission is required as information is furnished. The appeal is disposed off.

The appeal is accordingly disposed off.
