JUDGMENT

(Per Afonso Araujo)

By request dated 23.10.2008 the Appellant sought information under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (for short, 'The RTI Act') and required certified copy of the Opinion received from the Government Examiner of Question Documents sent for examination of Verna Police Station – Cr. No. 241/07.

2. The Respondent No. 1 by communication dated 1.12.2008 rejected the request of the Appellant under section 8(1)(h) as it will impede the process of investigation. Not satisfied with the decision, the Appellant preferred First Appeal and by order dated 22.12.2008 the First Appellate Authority maintained the decision of the Respondent No. 1. Hence, this Second Appeal.

3. The Appellant requires certified copy of the Opinion of the Government Examiner pertaining to the Cr. No. 241/07 of Verna

Police Station. It appears that this Crime No. was registered on the complaint of one Natividade Fernandes. Since the Appellant is not the Complainant in Cr. No. 241/07, is not entitled for the copy of the Opinion of the Government Examiner of Questioned Documents and rightly, the First Appellate Authority upheld the decision of the Public Information Officer stating that the information if provided would impede the process of investigation and it is exempted under section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act. Hence, the following order:

The Appeal is dismissed.
