ORDER

Complainant present. APIO is present on behalf of the PIO. The Complainant in his complaint has stated that he has not been provided the information by the Opponent free of cost and that the penalty of Rs.250/- per day delay be imposed on the PIO. Infact, the Commission in its order dated 3/1/2007 had directed the Opponents to provide the information to the Complainant on all the questions within a week's time. The Commission had also directed the PIO to show cause as to why the penalty should not be imposed on the PIO. The Commission after considering the reply of the Opponent by order dated 8/3/2007 dropped the proceedings against the Opponent. The Complainant, therefore, cannot make any grievance now regarding the imposition of the penalty. As regards to the other request of the Complainant to provide the information free of cost, the same cannot be entertained at this stage as the request of the Complainant seeking information was not under Section 7(5) of the Act. Hence, the complaint is dismissed.
